#### WHAT IS NEXT FOR PINEY RAIL RIDERS?

The appraisal is in and the next step in our goal toward purchasing the trail is fundraising. The appraisal came in and it's at \$1.1 million. If we were to receive a grant in the \$500,000 range, we would still have a shortfall of \$600,000.

There is a lot going on behind the scenes to try and make this happen. We have influencial people pulling for us. If we want them to take notice, we have a make a big splash. If we aren't willing to help ourselves, we cant expect them to help us either.

That is where our members and sponsors come in. We are looking to them to help by donating money or extending their memberships or sponsorships. There is not set amount you can donate and it is not mandatory. Your donation has no affect on your current membership or sponsorship or any future memberships or sponsorships. We are hoping that this ask is a one time thing.

But what happens if we don't purchase the trail? We know the owner, who is a founding member, wants us to have the club and trail. It is also his perogative to do what he wants with it. We can't and won't make assumptions about his plans. That is not for us to decide. The bigger issue is what happens to us if we don't. We can't grow or develop. We would have to rely more on membership money to repair things instead of developing things. We can not apply for grants without showing ownership of the trail.

#### **COUNTY ATV NEWS**

Clarion County has another Borough that has become open to ATVs. On February 8, 2024, Rimersburg Borough officially adopted an ordinance making it legal to operate an ATV on Borough Roads ONLY. The ordinance spells out that recreational vehicles using the streets must meet all criteria set forth by the state's All Terrain Vehicle Law and they must operate by the state's vehicle codes. Kids will not be allowed to drive on the roads and the vehicle must have state registration and insurance with the operator having a valid driver's license. The streets are not open yet until signs are posted that designate the streets are legal. Although the ordinance states it applies to all borough roadways, officials may limit access to certain streets. Vehicles may not operate at a speed greater than the minimum required to maintain forward movement within 100 feet of a dwelling between midnight and 6 am. Vehicles must also display headlights and taillights from sunset to sunrise and be equipped with a muffler in good working condition so that noise emission is not unreasonably loud. The ordinance establishes fines of up to \$300 per violation plus prosecution costs. There are no permit fees. Under regulations, recreational vehicles are defined as all-terrain vehicles, four-wheelers, motorcycles, motorbikes, dirt bikes, three-wheelers, bicycles, cars, and trucks not including snowmobiles.

New Bethlehem Borough voted in February to advertise their ATV Ordinance and it will be voted on at their March meeting.


