President Message Hello all Piney Rail Riders ATV Club Members

You may already know DCNR has asked us to host an event on the trail on April 17th at 10:30am and some of our local governmental people that supported our efforts to purchase the trail will be in attendance. I have attached the flyer to this email, it has details about the event and a RSVP link to register to attend.

If you are available and would like to attend, we could use the presence and help that day to show DCNR that we are a worthy cause for this grant and future ones. We have great numbers, but it is in the middle of the morning on Thursday so I completely understand it is not the easiest thing to come to, but if you can, please register.

We have cleared another hurdle as far as the grant goes as well. We received the first payment from DCNR, we now have \$473,995.08 in our grant account. This first payment will help us pay the lawyer, appraiser and surveyor. Once that is done, the rest of our documents can be submitted to DCNR for approval and the second half of the payment can be made.

As we get into the swing of the season, people may ask you some questions about us and how to ride or join. Our day passes can be done online and are \$10.00/day/machine and applying for one as far in advance is super helpful in getting them their confirmation back. The application must include an emergency contact that is **NOT** on the application on a rider.

Membership can be done online or through the mail, as always it's just \$40.00 and this includes you, a spouse or significant other and children that **LIVE IN YOUR HOME** and are under 18. You can list grand kids if they will be going along, as long as they are under 18 as well.

The Facebook group page, Ride the Pine, this is a private, members-only group page. There are questions that need to be answered in order to be approved. This page is one of the perks of being a member, so we want to keep it as MEMBERS-ONLY. If you invite a friend, they need to be a member first and answer the questions.

Please be safe as we start riding, watch out for each other, organize your own rides with friends, post photos of those rides, and remember that you represent the club. We want everyone to see us in a good light.



TRAIL ETIQUETTE

Please remember that Piney Rail Riders has access to the railbed only and any side trails that are not leased or maintained by the club must have permission from the land owner to access. As respectful riders, please keep your speed and noise to a minimum when passing camps or houses, and if you see suspicious activity or items that should not be on the trail, take a picture and contact Bob Guthrie or any officer.

REMINDER

Remember that we have logging being done on the trail. We are trying to keep the trail open during this time and we ask that you be courteous and patient when riding. Be **ALERT** that there may be trees on the trail during the process. If you see where they currently are working, snap us a photo and share the location. Thank you for your help and your patience.
