From PA State Rep. Josh Bashline

I applaud my colleagues for their hard work to make this happen.

A group of lawmakers announced portions of state highways could soon be opened to serve as connector roads between trail heads under a new PennDOT policy.

PA State Rep. Clint Owlett (R-Tioga/Bradford), PA State Rep. Martin Causer (R-Cameron/McKean/Potter) and PA State Rep. Brian Smith (R-Jefferson/Indiana) have been vocal advocates for expanding ATV riding opportunities both for riders' enjoyment and for the opportunities it can create for regional economies in the Commonwealth.

At a meeting with PennDOT Secretary Mike Carroll earlier this week, the lawmakers learned the agency has established a new policy that will help facilitate the opening of certain sections of state highways to serve as connector roads between trail heads. Under the policy, municipal officials can identify a specific section or roadway to serve as a connector and request a PennDOT review of their proposal. If PennDOT agrees, the municipality or municipalities in which the section of state highway is located must enact a resolution affirming the use of the road as a connector.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

When our membership packets are mailed out at the beginning on the year. You receive a map of the trail that the club has. This is the only property being a member gives you access to. Being a member does not come with perks to ride trails off of the approved route on the map. You either have to A: ride ATV approved roads or B: PERSONALLY get the land owners permission. You should carry written permission to use the adjoining property just like you would need to for hunting in PA. The club is not liable if you leave the trail at that point all liability is on you and anyone who follows you off the club designated route.

3rd Annual Dale Marsh Memorial Ride.

July 12, 2025

This year, we are doing things a little differently. The ride will be run on the Trail owned by the Piney Rail Riders. For those of you who are not familiar with them, they are a Non-Profit Organization focused on preserving places to legally and responsibly enjoy riding motorized off-road vehicles. Check them out on Facebook! Parking will be at the Piney or Limestone Trailheads. There will be no parking for Trailers at the Campground or Pavilion unless you are camping. Camping will be available by reservation. Contact Piney Meadows Campground at 814-715-3681.

Registration will begin at 8:30am, and riders will leave the campground at 10am, departing in both directions at your own pace. This year, there will be no appointed leaders, but you are welcome to come and join a group and enjoy a day of riding together.

Since the Poker Run will be run on a private trail, Prices for members and non-members will be different. Piney Rail Riders Members' Price will be \$20 per person. Anyone under 18 is not eligible to partake in the poker run but may ride free with a signed waiver. Non-Members Price will be \$20 a person and \$10 per Machine for a Day Pass for the Trail.

There will be 4 STOPs on the Trail and 1 at the Start of the ride. * Piney Camperound Pavilion.

Toward Brookville * The Log, * The Top of 949, Toward Clarion (Piney Trailhead), * Memorial Hill, * At Piney Trailhead IF THERE IS NOT A PERSON POSTED AT EACH STOP, CARDS CAN BE DRAWN WHEN RETURNING TO THE PAVILLION.

Please bring CASh to purchase food from the food truck.

There will also be a 50/50, Music, and Possible Chinese Auction (TBD).

50% of Take in for Poker Run will be paid out as followed

RESTRICTIONS

The creek crossing at One Eyes Valley (between East Reidsburg Road and the Allision Intersection) is blocked off. We are working with DEP to meet their requirements so we aren't fined for anything. **PLEASE DO NOT CROSS ANY CREEKS**. If there isn't a bridge, it's not a crossing.





RT 949

Heading East on the trail at mile marker 16.5 or as we have nicknamed it, the SS Minnow, there is a very dangerous area that is not ideal for entering the highway.

Please use the following detour: At around mile marker 16, make a right onto Swine Ford Road. At the next 4-way intersection, make a left onto Love Road. Run this out to the main road to make a right onto Rt. 949. Travel a short distance and take a left onto Dickey Road. This is sort of a blind turn so be careful. At the Y, stay to the left and you will intersect with the trail again. To continue heading East, make a right onto the trail.
